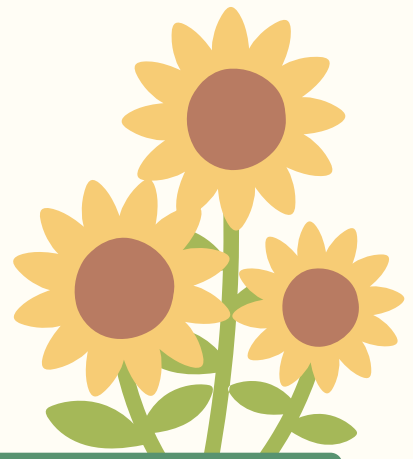

What are we Learning

Math

The big Idea for Unit 2 is students will be able to add two-digit numbers using various strategies. I have assigned IXL lessons. They have been working on the lessons if they finish their work early.
