Language Arts: This week we read chapters #7-12 from Who Was Jackie Robinson? This book will take us up to right around Spring Break! In writing we will continue to "fine tune" our persuasive writing pieces. We will begin more directed writing in preparation for the ILEARN.

Math: This week we finished up Unit 6: Connect Area and Multiplication with the unit test. We began Unit 11: Perimeter. This is a super short unit! *** Please put the multiplication and division flashcards to use!**

Social Studies: This week students enjoyed going more in depth while learning about state and local governments and discussing the essential question: How are people governed? Students also completed a worksheet where they shared what they would do if they were in the role of president. Next week students will be presenting an interesting fact they learned about their president from the president project!
