<u>Reading/Writing</u>: This week we read in the "big book" Animal Fact/Animal Fable. We also talked about what are facts and what are fables. Next week we will read "Spiders at Work" out of our big book. We continue to work on weekly writing, and we finished up a piece about things we are afraid of. We are focusing on details and adjectives to bring ideas alive to make our writing interesting. Friday, October 10<sup>th</sup> we will have an author visit. Annie Sullivan will read <u>Ghouldilocks and the Three Ghosts</u>. Books will be for sale, please see the flyer for ordering details.

<u>Spelling</u>: Unit 4 Spelling lists were sent home, and we continue to reinforce words during class time. <u>The pretest was on Monday, September 29<sup>th</sup>!!!</u> If a student gets an "A" on the pretest, they may opt to not take the final spelling test. All other students will be able to retake the test <u>Fridays (normally)</u> at the end of the Fundations unit. The final test for Unit 4 will be on Friday, October 10<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Math</u>: We are finishing Unit 3: Multiplication this week and a big review will happen next week with a test over the material. Students will have math homework Monday-Thursday.\*Students should be memorizing addition, subtraction and multiplication facts. Please put the flashcards to use! \*

<u>Social Studies</u>: This week in Social Studies, we explored what students already know, what they are curious to learn, and ways they can discover more about other people and cultures. We continued reviewing our unit vocabulary and completed an activity that helped us consider the influences of food, music, recreation, and language across North America. We also revisited our Essential Question: How does environment affect culture? Students had thoughtful discussions about how where people live can shape the way they celebrate, what they eat, and the traditions they practice.
