IREAD Testing: March 2-6

IREAD testing will begin on Monday, March 2, for all 2nd and 3rd grade students. Testing is scheduled to be completed by Friday, March 6. There will not be testing on Wednesday, March 4th.

On March 2, 3, 5, and 6, testing will begin **promptly at 8:00 a.m.** and conclude by 9:30 a.m. Please avoid scheduling appointments during these times. To help your child do their best, please ensure they:

- Arrive at school on time
- Get a good night's rest
- Eat a healthy breakfast

What is IREAD?

IREAD is an assessment developed to evaluate the reading proficiency of Indiana students, particularly focusing on foundational skills aligned with Indiana Academic Standards. The test is administered to all 2nd and 3rd grade students. The assessment consists of three segments that measure various reading skills, including phonics, vocabulary, and comprehension of both nonfiction and literary texts.

All employees and volunteers who have contact with children (including but not limited to coaches, classroom volunteers, field trip chaperones, nurses, and café workers) are required to complete the training prior to their first day of employment, service, or ministry, even if they have taken Virtus, Safe & Sacred, or other child protection programs. The course takes about 45 minutes to one hour to complete and includes video training and quizzes, a background check, and acknowledgement of a Code of Conduct. Choice Scholarship Information

Many of you may be aware that beginning in the 2026–2027 academic year, all Indiana families with students in kindergarten through 12th grade will be eligible for the Choice Scholarship (voucher program). This change removes previous income restrictions and allows every family to apply for vouchers to help cover tuition costs at participating private schools.

We have recently received clarification regarding the documentation required to process student applications.

- Choice scholarship (voucher) will open later in the spring.
- Every family requires proof of address / residency.

Any of the following documents with a printed address on it are acceptable as proof of residency:

- o Copy of Driver's License
- o Bank statement
- o Credit card statement
- o Loan statement
- o Lease agreement
- o Mortgage / rental contract
- o Property deed
- o Voter registration
- o USPS change of address confirmation
- o Insurance policy (homeowners, renters, auto, health)
- o Tax statement
- o **Please turn in this documentation as soon as possible, so that we can be prepared to process student applications when the window opens.**

Parents will still need to sign paperwork after it is processed in the school office.
