St. Matthew Catholic Church and School and the Archdiocese of Indianapolis utilize Safe Parish as part of our ongoing commitment to the care and protection of children.

All employees and volunteers who have contact with children (including but not limited to coaches, classroom volunteers, field trip chaperones, nurses, and café workers) are required to complete the training prior to their first day of employment, service, or ministry, even if they have taken Virtus, Safe & Sacred, or other child protection programs. The course takes about 45 minutes to one hour to complete and includes video training and quizzes, a background check, and acknowledgement of a Code of Conduct. Effective Year-End: Significant Change to Raise Right Program (formerly Scrip)

The Raise Right fundraising program allows members of our school and church community to buy, via the program's app or website, a wide array of gift cards at face value and then receive a rebate back that is shared with St. Matthew. Our active users have, to date, been able to receive their portion of the rebate amount back annually in the form of a payment by check back to them, or, if they choose, a payment directed to a church ministry, or to a child's tuition or 8th grade Washington, D.C. trip.

However, for a variety of reasons, the Raise Right gift card program is simply not the successful fundraiser for St. Matthew it once was, and participation has greatly declined in recent years. Because of this decline, the value of the program no longer offsets the administrative time and expense it takes to manage the sharing or "split" of the rebate. Therefore, after careful review and consideration, a decision has been made to end the Raise Right rebate share or split, effective January 1, 2026. We know this may be disappointing to the group who use the program to benefit from the split rebate, but we hope the logic of the decision will be understood and appreciated.

The good news is that the St. Matthew Raise Right program will continue! The difference will be that as of January 1, St. Matthew will receive 100% of the rebate of any gift cards purchased by a community member who participates in the program. By no longer managing the "split" of the rebate, St. Matthew will simply receive the full rebate from Raise Right with no additional accounting, administration or management needed on our end. We already have a group of active users who have dedicated 100% of their rebate to go back to St. Matthew, and we are hopeful that even more community members will sign up to help make the program a meaningful fundraiser once again for St. Matthew!


St. Carlo's Corner
