Reading/Writing: This week we read "Big Blue Whale". We watched a video about interesting whale facts to go along with the story. Next week we will read "Web Wonders". We did take our Checkpoint #1 test for Language Arts. We continue to work on weekly writing, and we finished up a piece about a great accomplishment we have experienced. We are focusing on details and adjectives to bring ideas alive to make our writing interesting.

<u>Spelling</u>: Unit 5 Final Test will be Friday, October  $31^{st}$ . If a student gets an "A" on the pretest, they may opt to not take the final spelling test.

<u>Math</u>: This week we reviewed our first grading period math skills and took the Checkpoint #1 test. Next week Unit 4: Use Patterns to multiply by 0,1,2,5, and 10 will start us on our multiplication facts journey. Students will have math homework Monday-Thursday. \*Students should be memorizing addition, subtraction and multiplication facts. Please put the flashcards to use! \*

<u>Social Studies</u>: This week in Social Studies, we reviewed and tested our knowledge of culture--what it is and why it matters. We began discussing how culture connects to life in the United States. Students shared their thoughts on what it means to have different cultures within one country and how beliefs and customs are observed.
