A Peek at Our Month

Reading: We started a nonfiction unit in reading. The students will study nonfiction texts including insects. They will use this information to write a research paper on an insect of their choosing.

Math: We started a unit on measurement this week. It may be helpful to have a ruler on hand at home with cm/in. If you need one for homework, please let us know.

Word Work: Students are learning about compound sentences, and how to combine two sentences with a conjunction. Ask them about FANBOYS.

Writing: They will continue writing in their white books by creating stories and editing their work. They will also start a research paper on insects.
