



## What is the IMPD Substation at Shadeland Station?

The North Shadeland Alliance, in partnership with Binford Redevelopment & Growth, established the substation in 2020 at the Shadeland Station shopping center (75th Street and Shadeland Avenue). Its primary goal is to enhance police presence in the area to help reduce crime. Designed as a space for officers to take a break during their shifts, the substation serves as a shared area where they can step away from their vehicles, much like leaving an office desk for a break room. It offers a place for officers to gather, decompress after stressful calls, write reports, connect with colleagues, grab a snack or drink, heat and eat their meals safely, and have a respite break.

## Is the substation open to the public? Can I speak to a police officer, file a report, or conduct other police business?

This is not a staffed police station. The substation is exclusively for North District officers and is not open to the public. Officers may not be inside, and they will not answer the door. It is not intended for patrolling or providing security for the shopping center or nearby businesses. Neither IMPD nor the City of Indianapolis funds or manages the substation in any way. It is managed by <u>BRAG – Binford Redevelopment and Growth</u> and is a 100% community-driven effort.

BRAG volunteers oversee the maintenance and supply of the substation. Neighbors and local businesses generously contribute supplies to support the police substation.
