

This is to advise the Trade Community that a fee change was requested by Port Liberty New York CES, located at 241 Western Avenue Staten Island, NY. The following fee increases have been approved by the Port Director, Port of New York/Newark, Customs and Border Protection.

Port Liberty CES:

- NII & AQI -\$355.00
- CET 20' minimum - \$800.00
- CET 20' maximum - \$850.00
- MET 20' minimum - \$800.00
- MET 20' maximum - \$850.00
- CET 40' maximum- \$1290.00
- LCL: \$20.00 per day per pallet

Customs Overtime Detail: \$50.00 per container plus customs surcharge divided equally per container examined.
