SUBJECT: Request for Comments Regarding the Future Status of the Customs Air Cargo Examination Facility (CACEF) at Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR)

DATE: **JANUARY 10, 2025**

PURPOSE: Issuance of this Public Bulletin serves as a notification to the public that the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Port Director will accept comments from the public, all importers, brokers, air cargo warehouse operators and stakeholders regarding the future of the CACEF.

On January 8, 2025, CBP held an open forum meeting to discuss the future of air cargo operations in the EWR community. CBP's current Memorandum of Understanding with H&M International Warehousing Inc. to operate the CACEF located at 157 Conrad Road #12 Newark, New Jersey expires on October 1, 2025.

The Port Director has determined that there is a need to hear from all stakeholders in the airport community. The public has the opportunity to submit written comments to this effect for review by the PD regarding the future of processing of CBP air cargo examinations.

Public comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 24, 2025, 14 calendar days from the date of this notice.
