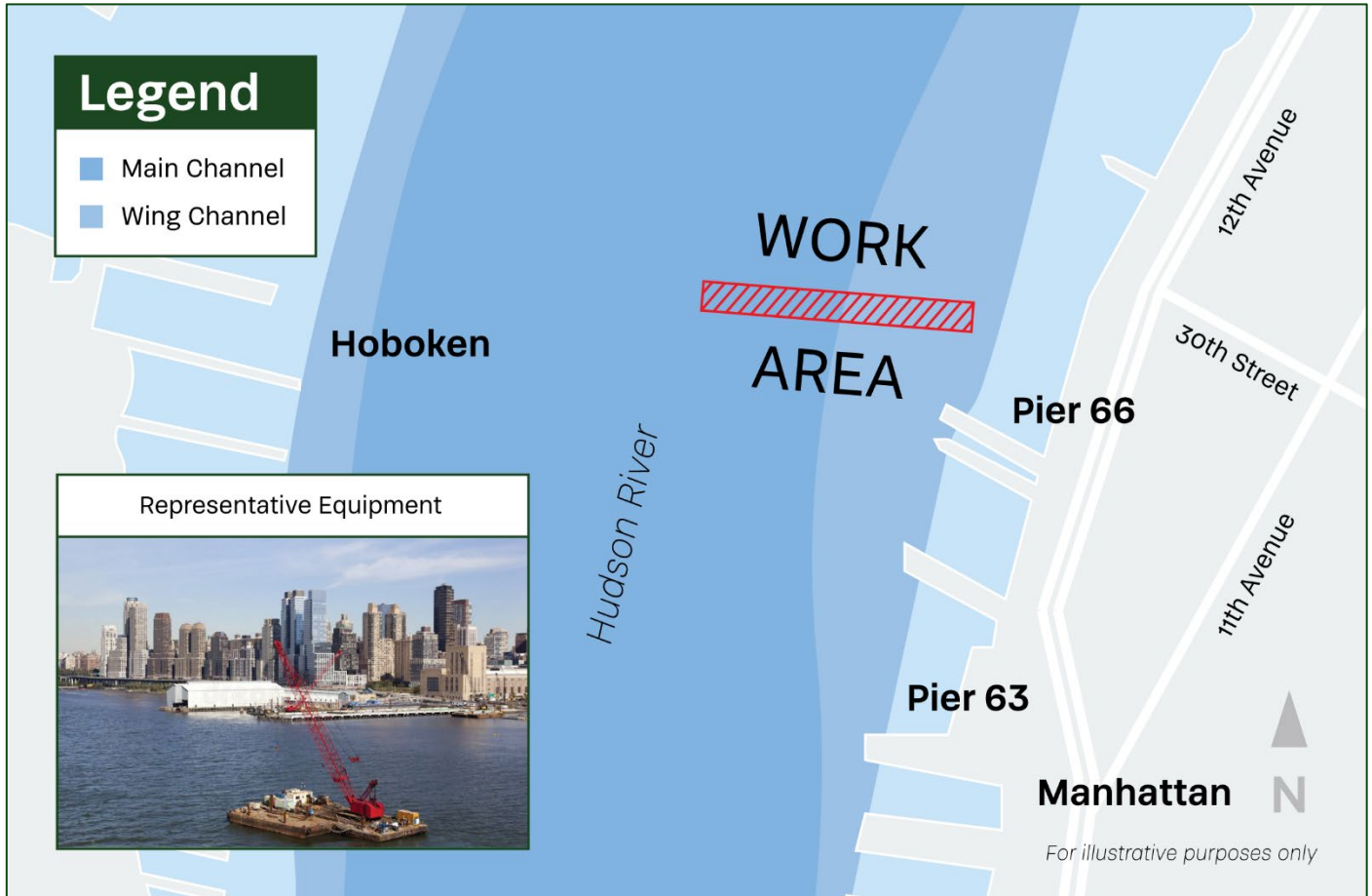


# Boater Safety Alert

The Hudson Tunnel Project will conduct marine surveys from July 1, 2024 – January 20, 2025.



The Hudson River Ground Stabilization (HRGS) project will fortify a section of the riverbed to enable tunnel boring machine operations for the future Hudson River Tunnel.

To ensure the safety of boaters and construction crews on the water, The United States Coast Guard (USCG) has issued the following **Notice to Mariners** (available at [USCG.mil](https://www.uscg.mil)):

*Weeks Marine will be conducting marine surveys, on the Hudson River bounded by the following positions: 40-45-17N, 074-00-51W and 40-45-16N, 074-00-35W, from July 1, 2024, to January 20, 2025.*

*Equipment on scene will be the **WEEKS 575 CRANE BARGE – 165 & 184 MATERIAL BARGE**, monitoring VHF-FM CH 13, 16, and 68 for any concerned traffic and is requesting an 8-hour notice for any vessel movement requests. Mariners are urged to use extreme caution and transit the area at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake, after passing arrangements have been made.*

**Safety is our #1 priority.** The Gateway Development Commission will continue to keep the boating community updated as this project progresses.
