


Boater Safety Alert

Weeks Marine is constructing a 110' wide x 600' long cofferdam in the Hudson River near Pier 66. Boaters are advised to stay a safe distance of 200' from all construction equipment/support vessels and use the western side of the navigable channel.



The Hudson River Ground Stabilization (HRGS) project will fortify a section of the riverbed to enable tunnel boring machine operations for the future Hudson River Tunnel.

HRGS equipment is currently working east towards the eastern side of the channel near Pier 66 Manhattan. All vessels are encouraged to navigate the area with caution and use the western side of the navigable channel until the sub bottom survey is complete on or around January 20, 2025.
