**SUBJECT:** Red Hook Container Terminal Pier 8 Designation

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this pipeline is to notify the trade community of an interim change to examination locations within the Port of New York/Newark.

**BACKGROUND:** The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey declared Pier 9A and 9B unsafe Red Hook Container Terminal and CBP have been ordered to vacate the building by September 30, 2023. Red Hook Container Terminal has proposed utilizing space at Pier 8 located at 2 Atlantic Avenue Brooklyn, NY. CBP is working closely with Red Hook Container Terminal and the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey to prepare the location. The Port Director has determined that Pier 8 shall utilized as a location where CBP will conduct examinations of cargo.

**ACTION:** Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. §§ 151.6 and 151.7, I am designating Pier 8 located at 2 Atlantic Avenue Brooklyn, NY as a place where merchandise will be examined by CBP. Effective October 1, 2023, CBP will conduct all types of examinations at Red Hook Container Terminal Pier 8 in addition to the current three (3) CES locations.
