WHAT IS A FUNDRAISER SIGN-UP PARTY?

A Kingsley FUNdraiser Sign-Up Party is a get-together meant to build community among Kingsley families and raise funds for the Kingsley PTA. These funds support many enrichment and school improvement programs that benefit students, teachers and families at Kingsley.

Each party is hosted by one or more Kingsley parents/families for a certain number of attendees. Kingsley families then sign up online for “tickets” to attend one or more party.

HOW DO SIGN-UP PARTIES RAISE MONEY?

Each party will specify an optional, suggested donation range (for example, \$2-\$20 per ticket) that attendees are invited to pay in exchange for attending. All donations will go directly to the Kingsley PTA.

WHAT KIND OF PARTIES WILL THERE BE?

Kingsley families are welcome to plan all kinds of parties. Examples from the past include:

- Snacks and games at a local park for students
- A dance party, bagels and a bike ride, or backyard BBQ for families
- Workout parties, Indian dinner party and poker night for adults

Parties can be simple or complex - the whole point is bringing people together to get to know one another and have fun!

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

EVERYONE! We would love to have each family join us for at least one event. Sign-Up parties are a great way to meet new people and make Kingsley a friendlier place!

HOW DO I HOST A PARTY?

You are welcome to host a party individually or (more common) to partner with a few other parents or families to host one. Hosts plan the party, cover the costs of the party and communicate with attendees prior to the event. Hosts also manage any donations received at the party.
