#### **Location:**

Sikorsky Aircraft, a Lockheed Martin Company,  
Stratford, CT

#### **Eligibility:**

Each troop may register a **patrol**, which is expected to be no more than eight Scouts and two adults. Scouts must be at least 14 years old and at least First Class. **Please note that preference is given to Scouts attending Camp Sikorsky for the first time.** At least one leader must attend from every unit. If female Scouts are attending, a female leader must attend. A talent release and COVID pre-event checklist is required from every Scout and adult. This will be provided once your unit is registered. Every effort will be made to accommodate those with disabilities.

#### **Cost:**

\$50.00 (for Scouts and adults), if paid by August 15, includes Merit Badge instruction, meals (Friday snack, all meals on Saturday, and Sunday breakfast), and Camp Sikorsky patch. The fee is \$60.00 after August 15.

#### **Registration Process:**

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and must be done on-line.
