(To receive Early Bird pricing, payments are due in full by Tuesday, March 28.)

Payment can be made by check (Troop 76) and given to Nicole Genna. All final payments are due in full by Tuesday, May 23.

Please keep in mind - for any scout that is signed up at the end of day on 3/12 for camp, the troop is obligated to pay Sequassen a \$50 non refundable deposit. Once we send the amount to Sequassen we are not permitted any refunds.

Chaperone Sign Up Here! Families are required to chaperone, including camping overnight. Parents need up to date Youth Protection Training in order to chaperone. Our troop's success depends on parent help!

Fees and Deadlines: As soon as you submit payment and initial forms, your Scout's Merit Badge selections can be approved by the Scoutmaster and then entered into the Sequassen system. Merit Badge sessions are filled on a first come, first served basis up to class sizes set by Sequassen.
