

The following reports, located on our [Purchase District UWF web page](#) (see website directions located in this newsletter), should be mailed, emailed, or texted to me:


Local Unit Mission Study Credit Report — Due June 1

Last year, Purchase District local United Women in Faith units read **305 books!** I would love to encourage you to read even more this year.

One way I have increased my own reading is by using the Hoopla and Libby apps through my public library who installed them for me on my Samsung tablet to check out e-books. Of the two, I personally find Hoopla easier to use.

Our Reading Program offers several plans to choose from, along with five key categories:

Spiritual Growth
 Social Action
 Leadership Development
 Education for Mission
 Nurturing for Community



Here are the available Reading Plans:

Plan 1: Read 1 book from each category every year.
Plan 2: Read 2 books from each category every year.
Plan 3: Read 3 books from each category every year, plus 5 additional books from any category.
Plan 4: Read 2 books from each category every year, plus 10 additional books from any category.

There are also additional ways to earn Reading Program credit:

- ↳ Audio books qualify.
- ↳ Listening to *Faith Talks* podcasts (2 or more episodes) earns 1 Spiritual Growth credit.
- ↳ Listening to *Voices from the Field* podcasts (2 or more episodes) earns 1 Education for Mission credit.
- ↳ Reading 6 issues of *Response* magazine earns 1 Nurturing for Community credit.
- ↳ Participating in a Mission Study on your own earns 1 Spiritual Growth credit.
- ↳ Leading or participating in a Mission Study with others earns 2 Spiritual Growth credits.
- ↳ Several movies are also available for credit, including: *Hidden Figures*, *Pushout*, *The Hate U Give*

By completing a Reading Plan and having your unit submit the Purchase District UWF Program Report to me by **August 1**, you will receive a Certificate of Recognition at our Annual Day.

I look forward to celebrating your reading accomplishments!

church. Our quarters are as follows:

- Quarter 1: 12/7/25 – 2/28/26
- Quarter 2: 3/1/26 – 5/30/26
- Quarter 3: 6/1/26 – 8/31/26
- Quarter 4: 9/1/26 -12/1/26

The yearly deadline to remember is the Quarter 4 report, which must be mailed no later than 11/15/26 to allow sufficient time for reconciliation and receipt by 12/1/26. Unfortunately, last year some reports were not received in time for 2025 reporting. This was not due to you, but to ever-changing delivery standards nationwide through USPS.
