



Training Center construction nears completion, to end by December

Construction work will be completed and workers will have left the property by the beginning of December, according to Tory Maye, deputy director of operations for the Department of Emergency Communications.

Maye said during the final weeks, inspections and punch lists will be completed. The department will have a chance to point out problems for the workers to resolve.

The parking lot was finished in late October, and carpeting was installed. Outstanding work includes window panes, gutters, landscaping and debris removal. Once the construction is completed, the gate will be replaced and furniture will need to be installed.

The \$2.8 million training center is 4,325 square feet. It was designed by the same firm that designed the main building, HVC Chenault. The construction work has been done by Brooks & Co. A ribbon-cutting ceremony with Mayor Levar Stoney and an open house are being planned for 4-6 p.m., Feb. 28.
