ZOOM BASIC INSTRUCTIONS

When you log on to Zoom, please remember to say "yes" or "approve" to any pop-up boxes requesting use of your audio/microphone and video

There are three ways to join a Zoom meeting:

1. Computer: If you have a computer with a microphone, you can download the Zoom application and join the meeting. (If you have a computer camera, you can join in with video, too!) Simply click the link provided by your meeting host, and you are ready to go!

To download the application, you can click the meeting link, and it will ask you to download (just make sure you do this at least 10 minutes before your meeting time); you can also [go here](#) and choose the first download option.

2. Phone App: You can join with your phone, like using Facetime. To do this, download the free app "ZOOM Cloud Meetings" from the app store. From within the app, you will be able to click "join meeting" and add the meeting ID provided by your host.

3. Phone Call: At the time of your meeting, call 1-312-626-6799 and enter the meeting ID provided by your host.
