With our space at a critical level, GraceWorks staff finds innovative ways to work from two separate, rented buildings. For example, during the onset of COVID-19 and the dramatic increase in demand for food, we were forced to use part of the thrift store to hold pre-loaded carts. Although we use every square inch of our campus for ministry, we have run out of room to grow, and parking is inadequate. Tucked away from the road, our buildings are not immediately visible to those seeking help. Additionally, the new property owner seeks to sell soon.

The time has come to consider a new facility. With anticipation, we are exploring the possibility of a capital campaign that will allow us to purchase property for a new campus. Can you imagine a facility where all those in our community feel the love of Christ as their basic needs are met? We can imagine it too, and with God's help it is within reach!
