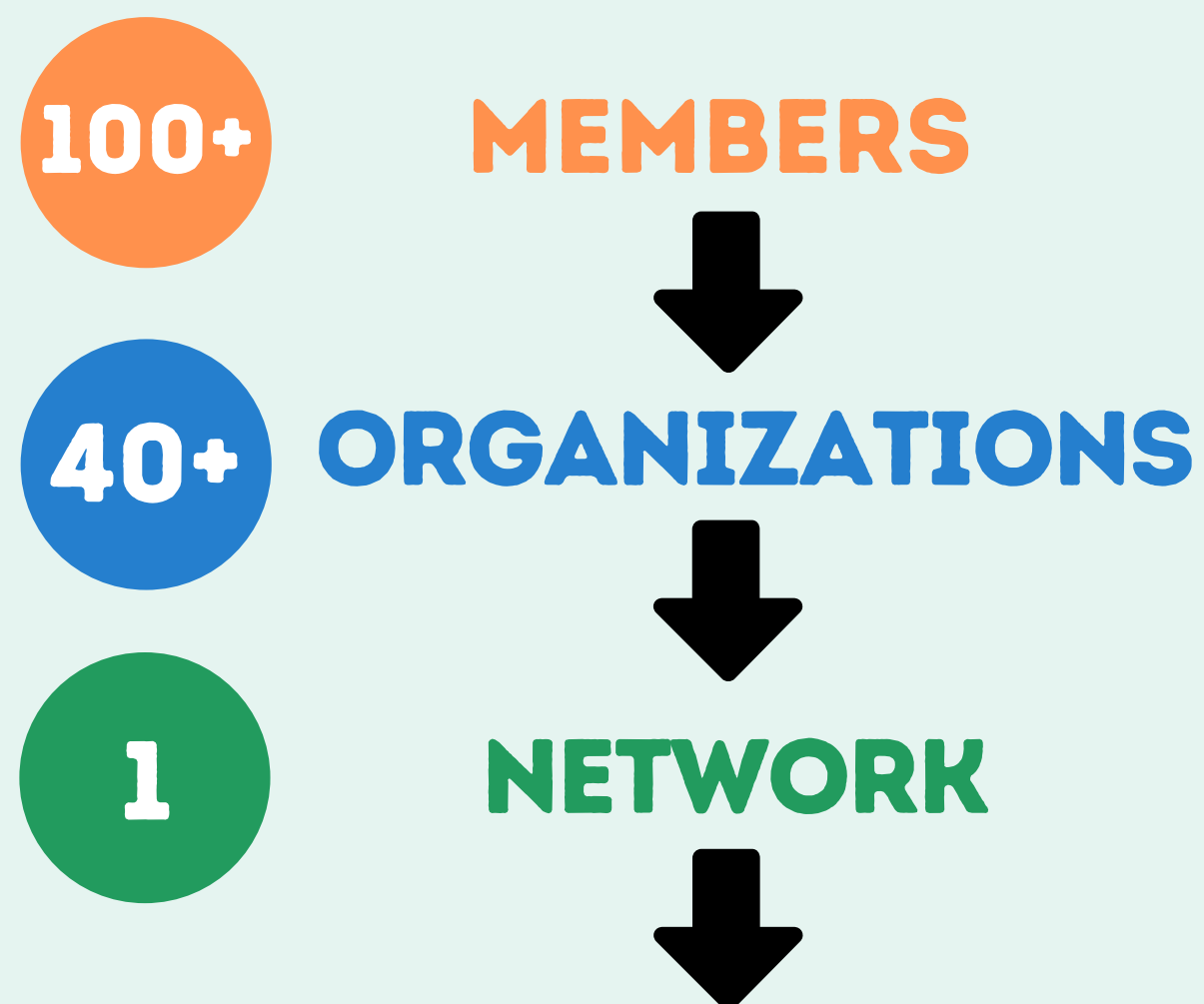

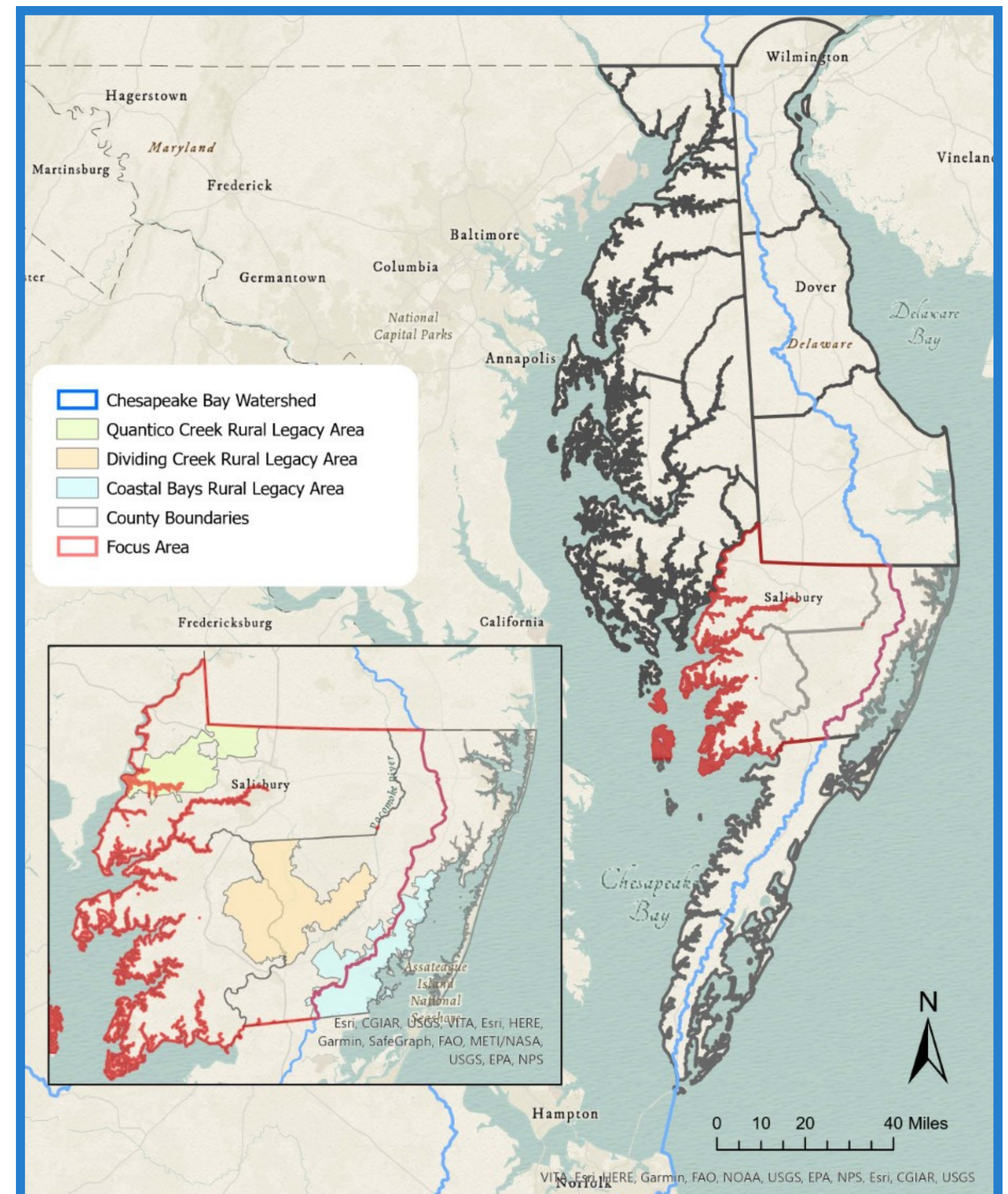
Collaborating on a Restoration & Conservation Strategic Action Plan for the Delmarva Peninsula.

OPERATING COMMITTEES

AGRICULTURAL LAND & FORESTRY MANAGEMENT



Works among federal NRCS, state, & private industry programs to:

- coordinate the enhancement and restoration of fish and wildlife habitat associated with working agricultural or forested lands

LAND PROTECTION



Works on multi-year land acquisition projects to:

- identify priority funding
- determine fee simple and conservation easement priorities by state

TOWN & URBAN



Works with communities for planning & implementation of projects relating to:

- green infrastructure for climate resiliency
- green space access
- innovative water quality solutions.
