We would like to provide the opportunity for you to introduce your community of friends to learn more about the **Academy**. The Academy will be accepting 60 additional 9th graders next year. When the school is complete with its growth, we will have a total of 480 students. If you are a member of a church, sports team, community organization or program, please notify your social network of this option.

The window for LBUSD high school registration closes at the end of December. **The Academy is not one of the choices on ParentVue**. We have a separate application process. Applications can be completed [online](#) or in the front office. Submitting an application to the Academy does not affect the CHOICE application, it provides students with another option. Our application deadline is February 3.

Some highlights about the Academy:

- Last year, we celebrated the opening of Intellectual Virtues Academy, A Long Beach Public High School thanks to nearly \$2.5 million dollars in grants.
- Academy students have proven accelerated growth in test scores across all subjects.
- 100% of our parents say that the Academy is a safe and supportive environment to learn.
- Academy students receive their own Google Chromebook with GoGuardian security filtration for home and academic use.
- Each classroom is connected to the campus-wide internet, and equipped with either a Smartboard, interactive white-board, or MacBook Air and projector.
- 90% of our faculty/administration either have or are in the process of receiving Master's degrees, including four doctorates (97% of parents agree our faculty is "high quality").
- Air conditioning is installed throughout the building and in every classroom.
- "Being a part of the Academy has changed me physically and mentally. I've learned here that it's okay to show humility and it is totally okay to ask questions." - Current Student
- The Academy is establishing an Innovative Lab to connect student curiosity with opportunities to explore through passion-driven projects.
- 100% of parents agree that the Academy is fulfilling its college/career/life readiness mission of equipping its students to be "deep thinkers".
- Our campus is alive with activity, with five times as many students participating in sports teams/clubs than typical public schools, and 78% participate in some after school activity.
- We will be enrolling 60 students for the fall of 2018.
- When the Academy is complete with its growth, there will be no more than 480 students total in grades 9th through 12th.
