### Redding Rancheria Community Fund Awards \$95,000 to 25 Organizations

The Redding Rancheria Community Fund, a fund of the Shasta Regional Community Foundation, is pleased to announce grant awards totaling \$95,000 to 25 local organizations in Shasta and Trinity Counties.
