COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Courses are open to anyone interested in the ministries of NMBDR.

IN THE BEGINNING: INTRO TO NMBDR — The basic training required for all new New Mexico Baptist Disaster Relief Volunteers. The class is also the opportunity for the required 3-year credential renewal.

DON'T POISON ANYBODY: FEEDING BASICS — The fundamentals of safe food handling and preparation. <u>Required</u> for those taking the QRK feeding class.

BEING QUIRKY: FEEDING WITH THE QRK — Training in the setup and use of the Quick Response Kitchen. The class is open to anyone interested in the feeding ministry.

FUN IN FLOOD & FIRE CLEANUP — An overview of the NMBDR Cleanup and Recovery ministry. Based on the SBDR Recovery Manual.

NOT THE TAX KIND: ASSESSMENTS — Developing accurate damage Assessments. Based on the NMBDR Assessment Manual. Ideally, participants will have cleanup & recovery experience or have taken the fire and flood cleanup class.

YOUR STORY: EVANGELISM IN DISASTER RESPONSE — How to share the gospel with disaster victims through your own personal story.

UP CLOSE & PERSONAL: INTRO TO CHAPLAINCY — An introduction and overview of the role and responsibility of DR Chaplains. Those wishing to become DR Chaplains will need additional classroom instruction.

CAN YOU HEAR ME NOW? NEW DIRECTIONS IN COMMUNICATIONS — An introduction to the DR Communications Ministry, and training in new methods and hardware for communicating when cell phones and the local internet networks aren't an option.

BETWEEN THE DITCHES: SAFE TRAILER MOVEMENT — Training in the safe and effective inspection, set-up, maintenance, and maneuvering of utility trailers.

CARE & FEEDING OF CHAINSAWS — Learn the safe and effective use of chainsaws, saw maintenance, and proper use of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE).

TO PACK OR NOT TO PACK: THE GO BAG — What to take, what to leave home, and what you can live without.
