<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (1) (A) 1. Housing facilities for dogs and cats must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	The roof of the shade structure had collapsed along the back portion of the facility in an enclosure housing three adult Australian Shepherds.

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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (1) (D) 2. Outdoor facilities for animals must include one (1) or more shelter structures that are accessible to each animal in each outdoor facility, and that are large enough to allow each animal in the shelter structure to sit, stand and lie in a normal manner, and to turn about freely.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	During today's inspection, there were two enclosures that did not provide enough dog houses or a dog house large enough to allow each animal in the enclosure to sit, stand, and lie in a normal manner, and to turn about freely.
<b>DATE:</b>	03/18/2020
<b>TIME:</b>	10:00 am – 8:00 pm

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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (1) (D) 2. In addition to the shelter structures, one (1) or more separate outside areas of shade must be provided by means of trees, permanent awnings, or suspended shade cloth or heavy duty tarps in good repair and firmly secured to a frame, large enough to contain all the animals at once and protect them from the direct rays of the sun.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	During today's inspection, tarps were provided for shade, however there were approximately 12 enclosures that had tarps that were not in good repair. Several were tore along the edges and others had been chewed on by the dogs.

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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (1) (D) 3. Building surfaces in contact with animals in outdoor housing facilities must be impervious to moisture. Shade structures were supported with wooden boards that the animals can come into contact with. These wooden boards were no longer impervious to moisture.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	Shade structures were supported with wooden boards that the animals can come into contact with. These wooden boards were no longer impervious to moisture.
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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (1) (D) 3. Building surfaces in contact with animals in outdoor housing facilities must be impervious to moisture.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	There were several wooden dog houses that were no longer impervious to moisture.
<b>DATE:</b>	03/18/2020
<b>TIME:</b>	10:00 am – 8:00 pm
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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (1) (D) 3. The floors of outdoor housing facilities may not be of bare dirt or sand; must have adequate drainage; and must be replaced if there are any prevalent odors, diseases, insects, pests, or vermin.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	During today's inspection most of the enclosures did not have adequate drainage. The enclosures were previously comprised of gravel, however the gravel has been worn down and partially washed away, exposing large areas compacted dirt throughout the primary enclosure and causing standing water. Numerous animals were observed to have wet feet, legs, and bodies.
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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (1) (D) 3. All surfaces must be maintained on a regular basis. Surfaces of outdoor housing facilities, including houses, dens, and the like, that cannot be readily cleaned and sanitized, must be replaced when worn or soiled.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	A majority of the dog houses throughout the facility need to be cleaned inside and out. The outside of the dog houses are caked in mud and several of them have gravel inside of them.
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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (2)(B)4. Exercise for dogs. Except as prescribed by rule, commercial breeders with more than ten (10) intact females must provide covered dogs with constant and unfettered access to an attached outdoor run.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	There was an adult Australian Shepherd cross, Snappy being housed in the whelping building that did not have constant and unfettered access.
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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (2) (C) 2. Feeding pans must either be made of a durable material that can be easily cleaned and sanitized or disposable.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	There were feeding pans in enclosures today that were chewed, causing sharp points. These feeding pans were no longer able to be easily cleaned or sanitized.
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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	Each licensee subject to the provisions of section 273.345, RSMo, shall provide continuous access to potable water that is not frozen and is generally free of debris, feces, algae, and other contaminants.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	During today's inspection, at least eight primary enclosures were observed to have empty water bowls. In addition, a majority of the water receptacles were observed to have dirty water or a build-up of debris in the water.
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<b>NON-COMPLIANT ITEM:</b>	2 CSR 30-9.030 (2) (E) 3. Premises must be kept free of accumulations of trash, junk, waste products, and discarded matter. Weeds, grasses, and bushes must be controlled so as to facilitate cleaning of the premises and pest control and to protect the health and well-being of the animals.
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	There was an enclosure housing two Australian Poodle crosses that had torn up pieces of a dog food bag in the enclosure.
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<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	The whelping building and the area behind the elevated whelping boxes had an accumulation of trash, junk, waste products, and discarded matter.
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
