FLANWR SUMMARY



Through a grant from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, we provided an entrance sign, interpretative sign, iron ranger and caliche parking lot for the Bahia Grande Unit.

FLANWR purchased 40 acres within the Bahia Grande Coastal Corridor, bringing the total conserved land to 50 acres. This helps with habitat connectivity for many native species.
