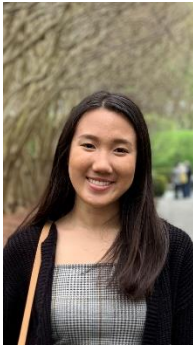


Greater Houston Women's Chamber of Commerce 2020 Scholarship Recipients

I want to study Biology in my undergraduate. And I'm planning to study Medicine. I want to be a doctor in the future because I love to help people!

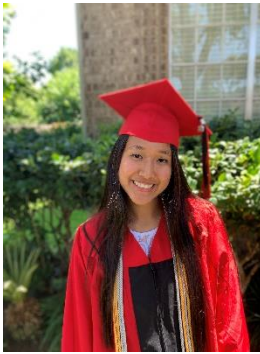
Taylor Belger – Stratford HS
