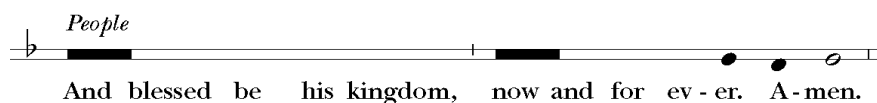
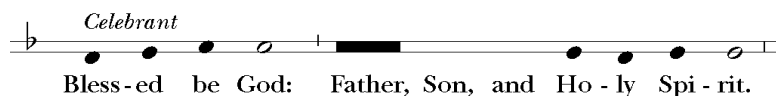

Isaiah 25:1-9

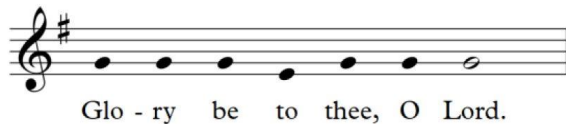
## THE HOLY GOSPEL

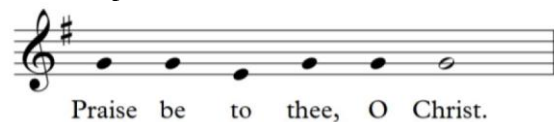

Once more Jesus spoke to them in parables, saying: "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding banquet for his son. He sent his slaves to call those who had been invited to the wedding banquet, but they would not come. Again he sent other slaves, saying, 'Tell those who have been invited: Look, I have prepared my dinner, my oxen and my fat calves have been slaughtered, and everything is ready; come to the wedding banquet.' But they made light of it and went away, one to his farm, another to his business, while the rest seized his slaves, mistreated them, and killed them. The king was enraged. He sent his troops, destroyed those murderers, and burned their city. Then he said to his slaves, 'The wedding is ready, but those invited were not worthy. Go therefore into the main streets, and invite everyone you find to the wedding banquet.' Those slaves went out into the streets and gathered all whom they found, both good and bad; so the wedding hall was filled with guests. "But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing a wedding robe, and he said to him, 'Friend, how did you get in here without a wedding robe?' And he was speechless. Then the king said to the attendants, 'Bind him hand and foot, and throw him into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' 

## THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE HOLY SACRAMENT

*The Church teaches that Christ is fully present in both the bread and the wine. Because of the coronavirus pandemic, only the Celebrant will receive the wine to avoid additional risk of transmission. To receive communion, please come down the center aisle, maintaining at least six feet between you and the person ahead of you. You are encouraged to use hand sanitizer before you receive communion. The Communion Minister, just having sanitized his or her hands, will drop the bread onto your hand without touching your hand.*

*All baptized Christians are invited to receive Holy Communion, without regard to denominational affiliation. If you have not been baptized or do not wish to receive Holy Communion, simply fold your arms across your chest, and the priest will know to give you a blessing instead. If you feel led to follow Christ in his call to be baptized, please see a member of the clergy immediately following this service to schedule your baptism.*

*Virtual worshippers are invited to pray this prayer:*

In union, O Lord, with your faithful people at every altar of your Church where the Holy Eucharist is now being celebrated, I desire to offer to you praise and thanksgiving. I remember your death, Lord Christ; I proclaim your resurrection; I await your coming in glory. Since I cannot receive you today in the sacrament of your Body and Blood, I beseech you to come spiritually into my heart.
