**SUMMER WORSHIP SCHEDULE STARTS JULY 7.** We're going to try something new at Messiah this summer by changing our Sunday morning schedule. Beginning on July 7, we will offer traditional worship at 8:30 am, a blended worship service and sunday school at 10 am and our Risk service at 11:15 am. Be sure to spread the word!

JUNE SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES AT MESSIAH. People who were affected by this spring's floods, or by last year's hurricanes, or by earlier storms or those yet to come, need your help. Here are three ways members of all ages and abilities can help provide the much needed relief.

- 1. **Sunday, June 9**, Messiah will be assembling 600 cleaning kits (flood buckets). Volunteers are needed to hand out supplies, and to gather them into buckets. If you can tote a bucket, or pass out supplies, or sit and count, you can help. Plan on coming to the fellowship hall after the worship service you normally attend to provide your talents in service to others.
- 2. Set-up crew members are needed on **Saturday, June 8**, starting at 9 am in the Fellowship Hall. Saturday tasks include bundling 14,400 trash bags into groups of 24; dividing 10,800 cleaning wipes into sets of 18; setting up tables; and staging over 5 tons of supplies for the next day's packing event.

  3. In late June, a team will be travelling to North Carolina to halp rebuild homes demaged by provious burging as Year
- 3. In late June, a team will be travelling to North Carolina to help rebuild homes damaged by previous hurricanes. You can help a family get back into their home and back to a "normal" life. Ability to swing a hammer is NOT a prerequisite. Training in many of the tasks needed to reconstruct a home can be provided on site in (usually) 3 minutes or less. More details to follow.
