



Golf Cart Usage Policy

Members or Guests of the Hinton Golf Club must abide by the following policies when renting golf power carts from the Hinton Golf Club:

- All golf power cart renters must abide by the rules of the day, in any form, whether verbally provided by the golf shop staff, posted in the golf carts, posted on the golf shop entrance or communicated by the email newsletter.
- Golf power cart restrictions are posted for the best interest, upkeep, maintenance and allow for the best conditions of the golf course at all times.

Rules of Golf Power Carts:

- Users must abide by the directional signage posted on the golf course on each hole
- Users must abide by all areas marked by ropes, stakes, barricades or signs to not leave the cart paths
- Users must not AT ANYTIME park the golf power cart within 10 meters of any green
- Users must ensure all riders on the golf cart have paid their fee to ride on their power cart at anytime
- Users must treat the golf power cart with respect as it were there own at all times

Failure to follow the golf power cart rules will result in the following:

- 1st offence - verbal warning from management
- 2nd offence - written warning from management
- 3rd offence - 30 day removal of rental privileges of golf power cart rental and/ or usage
- 4th offence - seasonal removal of rental privileges of golf power cart rental and/ or usage
