Student Placement Process

At University Park, we will create well-balanced classrooms to ensure all students and staff are set up for success. Below you will find the outline for what will take place in terms of placing students in classrooms for the 17-18 school year.

1. Class placement information sheet will be sent home via our newsletter in late March.
2. This spring, classroom/support teachers will begin discussions about student learning styles and begin discussions on student placement.
3. During professional development, each grade level will meet with the entire support staff to begin creating three well-balanced classrooms.
4. Staff will create three balanced classrooms and submit to Mr. Varveris before the end of the year.
5. Mr. Varveris will place teachers' names on class lists after the roster is made – this is to ensure our ability to create three well-balanced classrooms.
6. Parents will be informed through our newsletter in Early July.
