

Hey neighbors- If anyone has a 4th grade boy, I am coaching a Denver Lacrosse Club team this spring, and our roster currently stands at 14. I'd love it if it were closer to 21-22, since we will never have a practice or game with more than 18 at it in the first place, and there will be plenty of playing time to go around. A few facts about the team:

-We are going to be playing at a blue (novice) level, so if your kiddo has never played before, or has minimal experience, this team could be a great fit!

-We will likely practice on Tuesdays/Thursdays at Eastmoor Park, from 4:30-5:45PM.

-Practice will likely begin Tuesday, 03/10. Games will likely begin Saturday, 04/04 and will usually be on Saturdays, often in south Denver/the south suburbs.

-Our team is really "mutt" with kids from all around the area, but I have a decent contingent who attend Slavens School, Asbury Park Elementary, and St. Vincent de Paul, so there's a chance for a built-in carpool there.

-Dues are around \$350, and include a uniform, and practice/shooter shirt.

-I can help you source equipment relatively cheap if you don't have it. As with any sport, lacrosse can be crazy expensive, if you have to have the slickest, newest gear. Or, if you source intelligently, it can be done on the cheap.

PLEASE- Don't let \$\$, or lack thereof, be the reason you'd pass on the opportunity of your kiddo playing. I'm happy to advocate on your behalf if funds are tight.
