


SWEET PEAS

MORE ABOUT THE CHILDREN'S ART SCHOOL

The Children's Art School was established with the belief that creating art is an integral component of a child's cognitive and personal development. The Children's Art School is devoted to nurturing a child's artistic and aesthetic growth. Our classes are for the interested and talented student who wants more art enrichment than is available in the traditional school setting. The workshops stress creative thinking skills by engaging children in the process of giving ideas form. Our classes involve children in the creative process and are not focused primarily on creating art projects. The courses are put in art historical or cultural context to nurture aesthetic literacy. The Children's Art School is directed by Jo Duranceau who is an educator for museums and schools. Ms. Duranceau has a Bachelor of Arts in Art Education, a Master of Arts in Art History and a State of Colorado teaching License with a K-12 Art Endorsement. She has taught and originated numerous children's programs including series for the Denver Art Museum, Botanic Gardens and the Arvada Center. The Children's Art School is a Community Resource for the Denver Public Schools, the Denver Public Libraries and develops programs for organizations such as Scholars Unlimited.
