ASPIRE also fosters a vibrant community of practice, enabling coaches to learn with and from one another while building meaningful professional relationships that extend beyond the program.



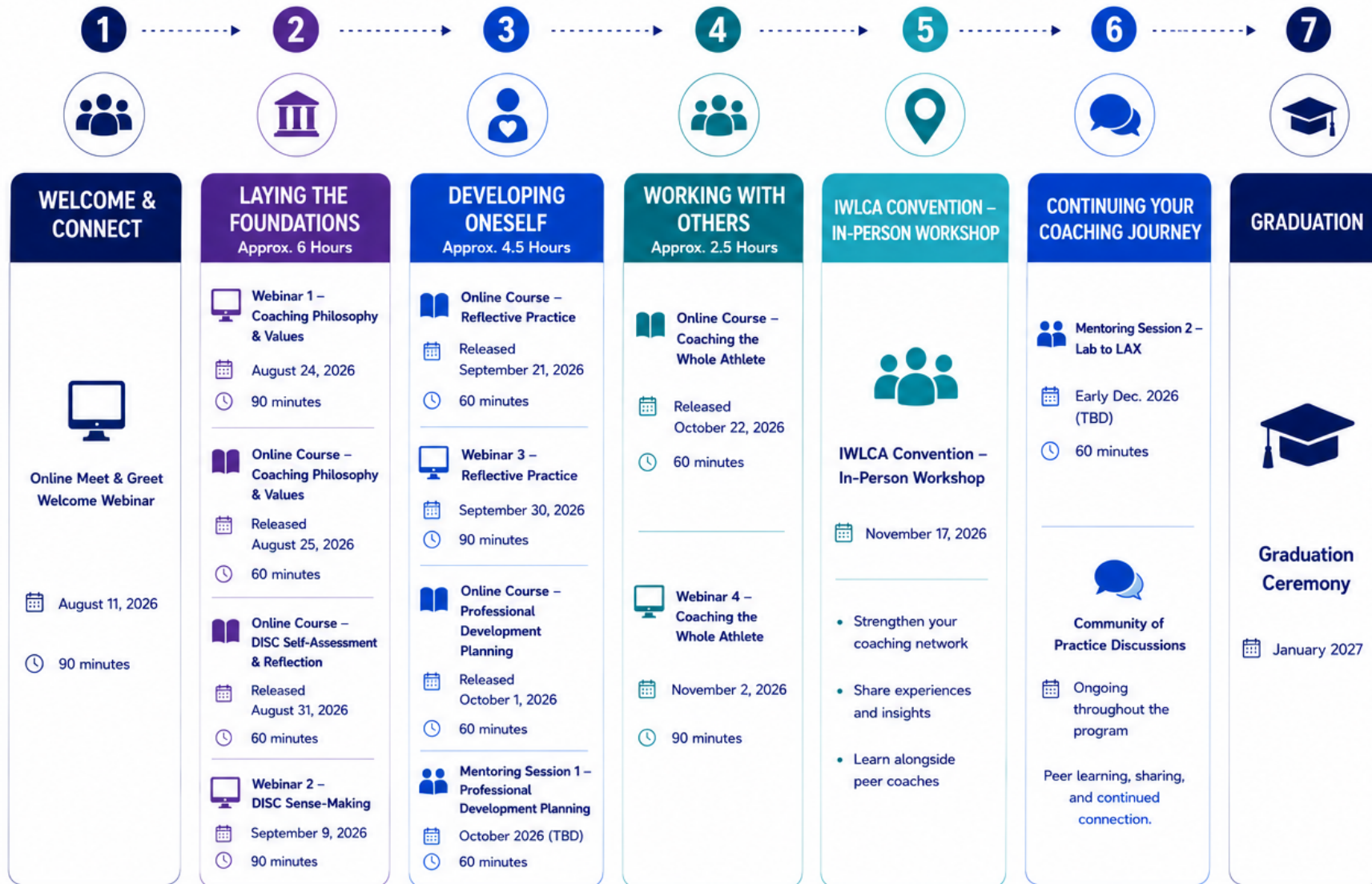
