Flexibility within our programs allows us to better meet the individual needs of each child and their family.

HALF-DAY PROGRAMS

We offer morning classes for young children with two, three, and five day options depending on the child's age.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL EXTENDED CARE WITH ENRICHMENT

Additional supervision and stimulation is available in our extended care program with STEM, art, and language enrichment activities.

ON-SITE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

We host on-site commercial activities so families can conveniently eliminate having to transport their child to another location. Activities offered may include *Soccer Shots*, *Tennis Titans*, and *Tumblebear Gymnastics*.

SUMMER CAMP SESSIONS

One-week themed camps are available the mornings of select weeks. They provide fun-filled learning experiences to encourage exploration of the world around us.

ENROLLMENT

You do not have to be Lutheran or a church member to enroll your child. Children must meet the age and potty-training requirement for their class. A completed physical form and a copy of your child's birth certificate are required for registration. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and must be completed online.

HIGH-QUALITY FOUNDATIONAL LEARNING TO FOSTER EARLY DEVELOPMENT

Our curriculum is aligned with the *Illinois State Early Childhood Learning Standards, Benchmarks, and Goals* and with the *Illinois State Kindergarten Individual Development Survey (KIDS)* so that your child is prepared for kindergarten. Activities that are age-appropriate and build on previous learning ensure that skills needed to be successful in school, such as initiative, curiosity, creativity, attentiveness, cooperation, perseverance, self-regulation, self-help, independence, negotiation, and adaptation, are nurtured.

SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT: Young children need socialization as well as academic stimulation. Engaging in purposeful, structured play helps them learn how to positively interact with peers and adults and how to process their feelings in acceptable ways. It also develops their oral language, creative arts expression, and love of learning.

COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT: The use of integrated thematic units allow children to develop science and social studies knowledge and skills by exploring family, community, events, people, and the natural/physical world. Children discover number concepts, relationships, and operations; geometry; patterns; sets; categories; and measurement in math. Activities occur in a variety of group settings and are multi-sensory in nature.

LANGUAGE & LITERACY DEVELOPMENT: Books are read aloud so children develop story sense, vocabulary, and reading appreciation. Children learn the letters and sounds of our language, print concepts and conventions, and early writing/composing skills.

PHYSICAL & HEALTH DEVELOPMENT: Children learn how to take care of their body through good hygiene and to make healthy, safe choices. Large muscle and fine motor skills, eye-hand coordination, and physical control are practiced daily.

SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT: One additional benefit of the ELC is that your child learns about God and His love for us. A daily Bible lesson is taught. Once a week the children go into church for a devotion led by Pastor.
