



## Elementary School Tuition for Grades K-6

### Tuition Structure

#### Tier 1: Maximum Tuition

- \$15,000 for the first child
- \$14,000 per child if there are two children
- \$13,000 per child if there are three children

#### Tier 2: Subsidized Tuition

- \$11,500.00 per child

#### Tier 3: Subsidized Tuition

- \$8000.00 for first child
- \$7500.00 for second child
- \$7000.00 for third child

Upon Request - (FAST is no longer needed.)

### Partnership Model: Parents & School

The true cost of education per child is \$25,000, covering:

- High-quality academic and Torah education
- Extracurricular activities
- Nutritious lunches
- Extended school hours (8 AM – 5 PM) to support working families
- Parents and the school are partners in education.
- Parents are asked to pay as much as they can within their ability.
- The school is committed to raising the remaining balance to ensure financial sustainability.

### Flexible Payment & Fundraising Model

- Trust-based system: Parents self-report what they can afford within the tuition range.
- Fundraising Tuition Credit:
  - Each family can raise approximately \$2,500 per child and receive a \$2,000 discount on their tuition.
  - Two major fundraising initiatives, one in the Fall and one in the Spring will help families reduce tuition costs which will be applied towards the end of the year.
