

EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Pathway to Adventure, Boy Scouts of America's Executive Committee establishes the council's strategic vision and program, implements the council's resolutions and policies, and support the council's activities. The Executive Board is a decision-making body rather than a study and discussion group. Detailed analyses of the various phases of council operation are made by the appropriate committees, who then present recommended plans and alternate courses of action to the Executive Board for decision.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Pathway to Adventure, Boy Scouts of America's Executive Committee of the Executive Board shall have and may exercise all the necessary powers of the Executive Board in the management of the corporation during the intervals between the meetings of the Executive Board, but in no event shall the Executive Committee act contrary to action theretofore taken by the Executive Board or take action prohibited by law or these bylaws to be taken by a committee. Minutes shall be kept of all Executive Committee action and reported at the ensuing meeting of the Executive Board for its approval

ADVISORY COUNCIL

The Pathway to Adventure, Boy Scouts of America's Advisory Council is an association of community leaders and seasoned Scouters committed to promoting and supporting Scouting throughout the Council. The purpose of the Advisory Council is to provide guidance and support to the Executive Board, serve as ambassadors for the Council, and help ensure the Council's success.

ASSOCIATE BOARD

The Pathway to Adventure, Boy Scouts of America's Associate Board is an association of adults committed to promoting a new 21st Century Scouting program and becoming leaders through effective community action, including volunteer service, social fundraising, and youth leadership development.
