

Priorities Discernment Committees

Background

The bishop search process, which engaged a wide array of Episcopalians in Minnesota, and sought to gain clear direction for the next chapter for ECMN as a body, surfaced values and several areas of strategic work that needed to be prioritized.

Since the election of Bishop Loya, he has distilled the learnings from the bishop search process into 4 priorities: discipleship, justice, faithful innovation and vitality.

The Bishop, in partnership with ECMN Council, is now launching discernment committees, which will further explore these areas of strategic work. Through prayerful discernment, these committees will craft recommendations that will be used by ECMN Council and the Bishop to frame the budget, and the overall work of the organization.

These Discernment Committees are meant to

Provide prayerful recommendations as to how ECMN can more effectively live out and operationalize discipleship, justice, faithful innovation and vitality, on a systemic, faith community and individual level.

Their work will be to:

- Let God lead
- Acknowledge that the church is learning something we don't already know.
- Pray, play and practice
