The ideal candidate is a self-motivated, organized and detail-oriented individual. The successful candidate will possess excellent analytical, verbal and written communication skills and be able to work to strict deadlines while contributing to a professional working environment.

Candidates must have:

- Proof of registration and certification with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba
- Canadian Medical Protective Association (member in good standing) or acceptable alternate
- Demonstrated computer proficiency
- Minimum of 2 to 3 years' experience in a community health setting
- Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS) certification
- Satisfactory Criminal Record check and Child Abuse Registry check

Assets:

- Knowledge of applying principles of harm reduction and trauma informed care to practice
- Understanding of and commitment to providing pro-choice reproductive health care
- Commitment to providing medication abortion care and follow up
- Proficiency in both official languages or other language
- Knowledge about women's health issues and community resources
- Public speaking experience
- Medical training at an accredited university (Family Practice graduate preferred)
- Commitment to decolonize their practice by uprooting colonial presence and power in Western practices and working towards more traditional medicine
