Employees can obtain the COVID-19 vaccine on County time (with supervisor approval) **THURSDAY, June 17, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.**



Children who are 12 years of age and older may now receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine at the County onsite location listed above. NOTE: only the second dose of the Pfizer vaccine will be available.

A legal guardian must be present with a minor (12 to 17 years of age). We will provide both the Pfizer (12 and up) and Johnson & Johnson vaccines. **No appointment necessary.**



What you need to Bring

- Completed and signed [COVID-19 Vaccine Screening and Consent Form \(complete in advance\)](#).
- Photo ID card. Minors between 12 and 18 years old must bring student ID, driver's license or other identification.

Other Important Information

- Any family member of an employee, whether they reside at the same residence or not, can receive the vaccine

- Employee does not have to accompany a family member
- Casual and contract employees can receive the vaccine



- Bringing your County badge is NOT required, but you MUST bring a Photo ID
- You will not be asked to provide proof of insurance or an insurance card
- There is no cost to employees or their family members for receiving the vaccine
