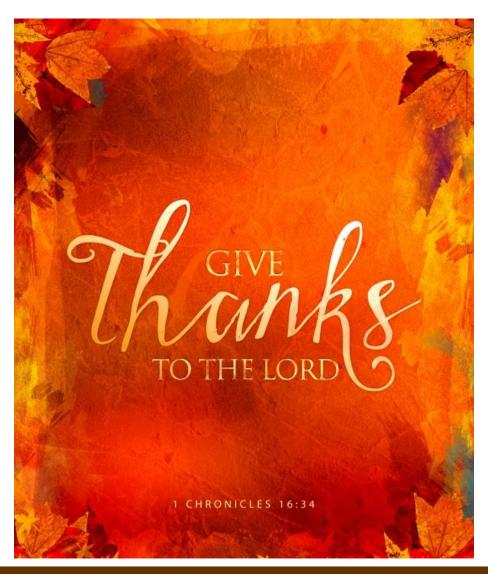

## What You Made Possible through Matthew 2540 in 2025

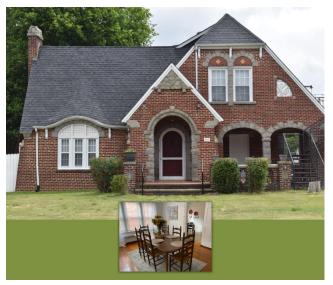
83 children had a successful school year under the guidance of 16 loving, nurturing staff. A June mission team saw 295 patients, filled 623 prescriptions, dispensed 700 parasite treatments, 138 reading glasses, 350 fluoride treatments and handed out 800 toothbrushes & toothpaste, 2880 sanitary supplies and 14,000 vitamins. Our dentist pulled badly decayed teeth for 90 people. Our hairstylist gave 45 haircuts. The children were

delighted to visit the zoo and thrilled to get their own illustrated Bibles. The team created a hands-on student career fair and helped the daycare, pre-primary, and grades 1-6 move into new classrooms. We are breaking ground on the 7<sup>th</sup> grade classroom in November, trusting God we will raise that \$40,000 by year's end. I already have pledges for \$26,000 of that. We also have pledges for \$16,000 toward a new school van. It will be nice for the kids and teams not to be stranded by the side of the road and to have more reliable transportation for the school staff to use to obtain groceries and school supplies. I am still investigating where in Guatemala to purchase this van and how much it will cost. If you gave directly to Matthew 2540, you will receive your 2025 to date giving statement by email in November. Your official one will come in January. This one is so that you can contact Lynn if you feel there is a discrepancy or just want to know what you've given so far in case you'd like to make another donation before the year ends. (If you gave through Immanuel, that will not be noted on our email.)

#### NEWS FROM WOMEN OF IMMANUEL



Kinard Manor, the women's transitional recovery house located in Greenwood, is currently undergoing some major changes and renewal. It has recently divested from Lutheran Services of the Carolinas and is now a vital ministry solely under the South Carolina Synod.

This program will be following a treatment program titled "We Came to Believe" with a mission to offer hope, love, and a new way of life by providing safe transitional housing, teaching skills for empowerment to self-sufficiency, and facilitating possible reunification with children and families.

As a result of these changes, it is even more critical that we continue to support this ministry with not only our prayers and our love, but we will also need to help in meeting other basic needs for the success of this mission. The Ladies of Immanuel are currently gathering the following items that have been identified as a great need for the residents of the home:

BLANKETS (twin or full/new or gently used)

WINDOW BLINDS (size to be determined-see Pastor Chris)

BARS OF SOAP

BATH TOWELS (new or gently used)

HAND TOWELS (new or gently used)

WASH CLOTHS (new)

EYE MASK

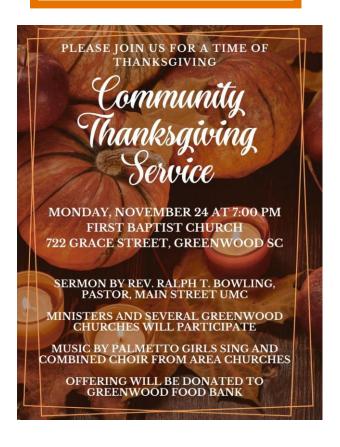
