

RICHARD MORGAN, D.O. graduated from the New York College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1998 and completed his residency in PM & R at NYU Medical Center in 2002. A common dental procedure exposed Dr. Morgan to the world of opiates, which changed his life forever. A series of bad choices and unfortunate circumstances fueled by his addiction led Dr. Morgan to a federal indictment and, ultimately, a 14-year federal prison sentence. Dr. Morgan now spends his time not only educating the future doctors of America, but continues to share his story with the student population, as well as clinicians everywhere. Dr. Morgan's goal is to educate other healthcare personnel on how to recognize the signs and symptoms of addiction, and the resources available to help them.
