

Handbook Changes and Clarifications 2025-2026

The information below is intended to provide brief information on changes and updates to the Student-Parent Handbook. In most cases, these updates indicate relatively minor updates, corrections, or rewrites for brevity and clarity. More significant changes are outlined below.

Changes in Policy - Please review full details on the pages indicated below:

Use of Cell Phones and Other Electronic Communication Devices - page 29

- Cell phones are required to be powered off throughout the school day.
- Use of cell phones for any reason will no longer be permitted in classrooms.
- Smartwatches and AI Glasses are specified as prohibited electronic devices.
- Until further notice, students will be permitted to use cell phones during lunch, but only in the cafeteria, gallery, or picnic tables
- Parents requiring urgent communication with their child during the school day should contact the school office directly.

Dress Code - page 36-41

- As with other dress code items, if a student is in violation of the skirt length rule and cannot immediately adhere to it (i.e unrolling the skirt to the proper length), students may be kept from returning to classes until they are in compliance.
- Alternatively, the student may purchase tights from the school and wear them for the duration of the day in order to be in greater compliance with the dress code.
- Students persistently in violation of this rule may be required to wear uniform pants.
