Screening your Patients – Questions to ask

Screen your patients BEFORE they arrive and at the time of appointment reminders, ask these important screening questions:

1. Have you traveled internationally in the past 15 days?
2. Have you come into contact with anyone who has traveled internationally in the past 15 days?
3. Have you come into contact with anyone who has tested positive for the COVID-19?
4. Have you or any member of your household been to any areas of the US with high infection rates since March 7?
5. Do you currently have a cough/cold?
6. Have you been sick in the past 14 days?
7. Do you currently have a fever?
8. Have you had a fever in the past 14 days?

If your patients answer "yes" to any of these questions, it is strongly recommended you postpone their appointments to a later date.
