**START ANY WHERE YOU WANT!**

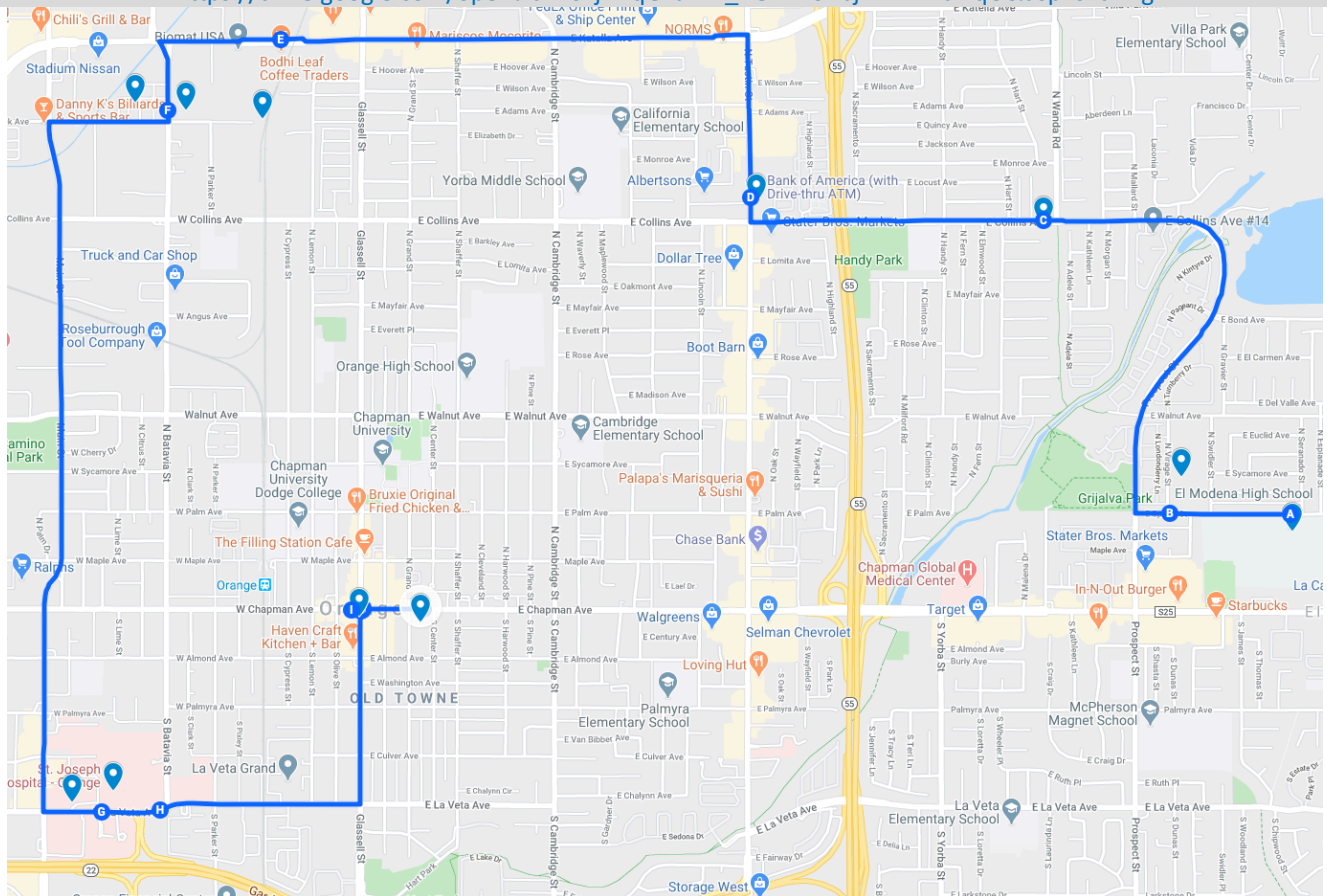
(the letters correspond to the map and not meant to be the order)

- A. EL MODENA HIGH SCHOOL** (3290 E Spring St)
