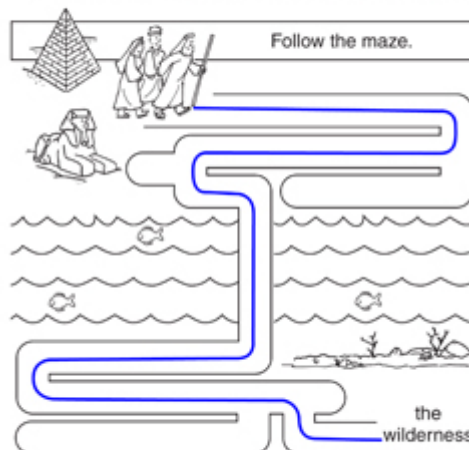

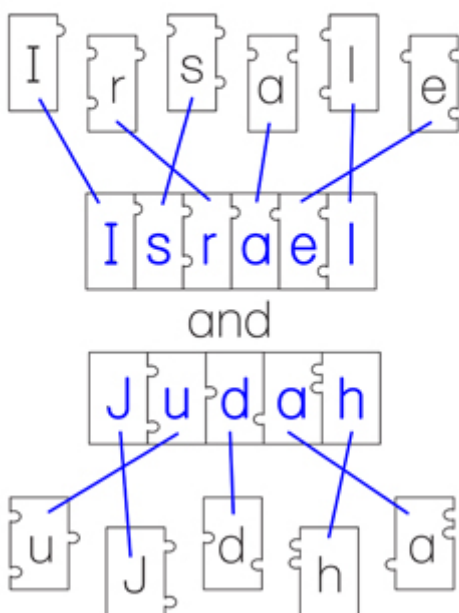

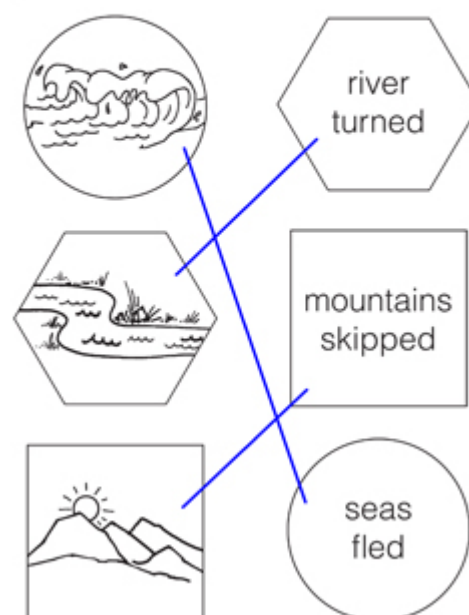

The Parable of the Unmerciful Servant


Peter asked Jesus,





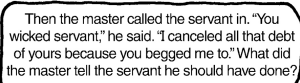

He brings peace and joy and right.

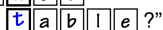

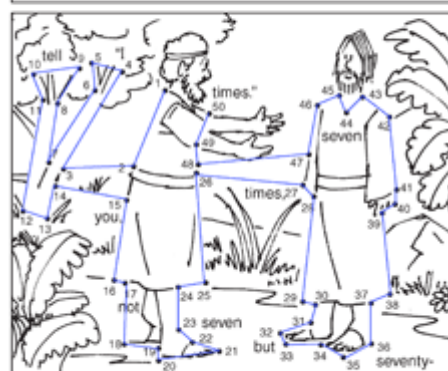
