


Wreath Photo Craft



Supplies you'll need:


- ☐ 6-inch paper plate (1 per child)
- ☐ Green paint
- ☐ Red paint
- ☐ Q-tips or paint brush
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Hot glue gun, craft glue or tape
- ☐ Photo
- ☐ Ribbon (optional)

Instructions:

1. Fold the paper plate in half and cut a circle in the center.
2. Use the Q-tips or a paint brush to apply green paint to paper plate around the entire plate. Add red paint for berries.
3. Attach photo to back of plate so that the photo shows through the center hole cut.
4. Optional: Attach a bow to the front and/or string to the back to hang.

Star Sewing Card

Matthew 2:1-23



Supplies you will need:



| <input type="checkbox"/> Yellow construction paper | <input type="checkbox"/> Glue |
| <input type="checkbox"/> 3 yards of yellow yarn | <input type="checkbox"/> Hole punch |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Blue cardstock or construction paper | <input type="checkbox"/> Scissors |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Tape | <input type="checkbox"/> Optional: Glitter or puffy paint |

Instructions:

1. Cut a star shape out of yellow construction paper.
2. Cut a piece of 8.5" x 11" blue cardstock in half and punch holes as shown above.
3. Put yarn through the hole at the top and tape the end of the yarn to the back. Continue to sew the card, looping yarn back through the top hole each time.
4. Glue the paper star on top of the yarn. Optional: Add glitter to the star and blue paper.

Star Template


Print or trace this star onto yellow paper for Step 1.




Snowflake Star




| <input type="checkbox"/> Craft Jewels & Glitter | <input type="checkbox"/> Glue |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Construction paper – any color! | <input type="checkbox"/> Hole Punch |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Scissors | <input type="checkbox"/> Yarn or String |

Instructions:

1. Fold the paper in half the long way. Then fold again.
2. Cut out your “snowflake” star. Remember, do not cut all of the folds or it will not stay together.
3. Decorate your star!
4. Once dry, punch a hole in the top and tie a piece of string through the top to hang.
