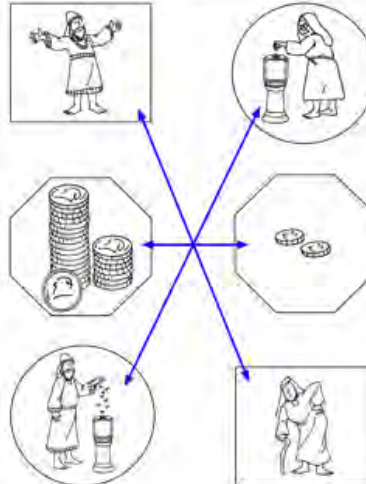

### Jesus Was Sacrificed for Us

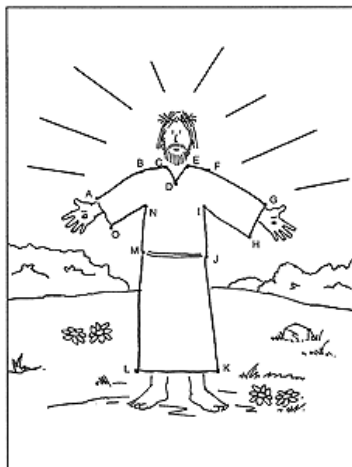
High priests entered the Most Holy Place every year to sacrifice an animal.

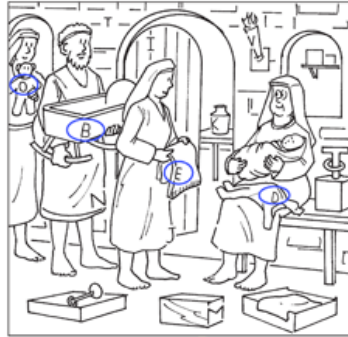

### Ruth and Boaz Marry

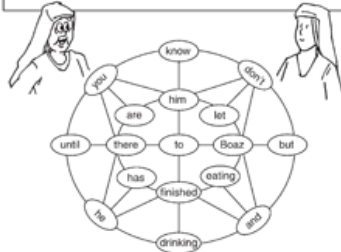
Naomi said to Ruth, "I should try to find a good home for you, where you will be well provided for."



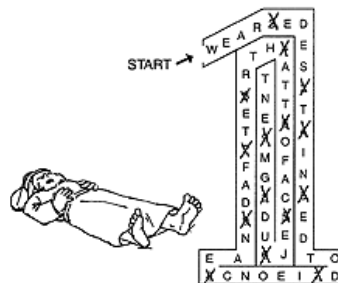
