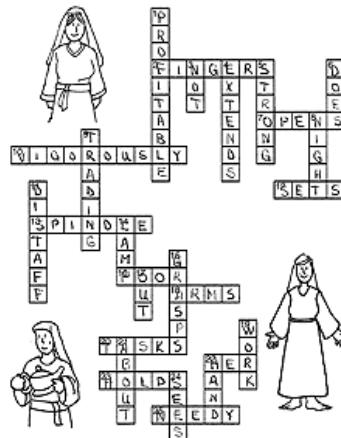

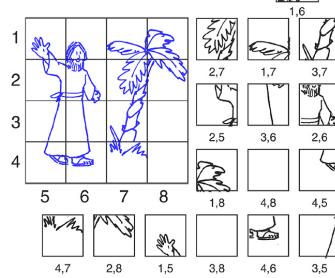

Two Kinds of Wisdom

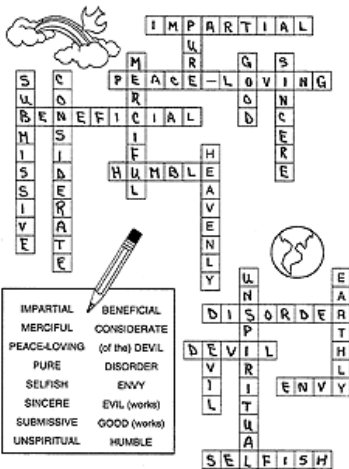
James tells us that good deeds are the mark of a wise person.
