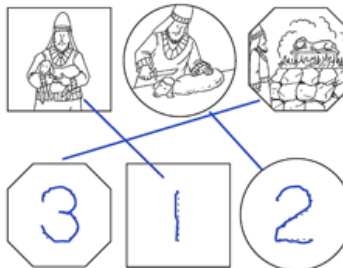

A Permanent Priesthood

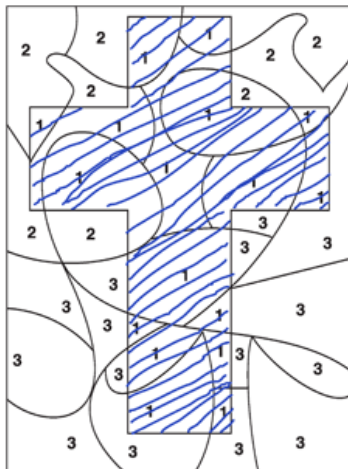
Priests had to offer sacrifice for their sins and for the sins of the people many times.

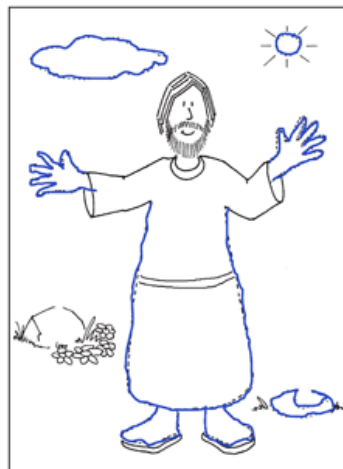
Jesus offered Himself as a sacrifice once, for all believers.

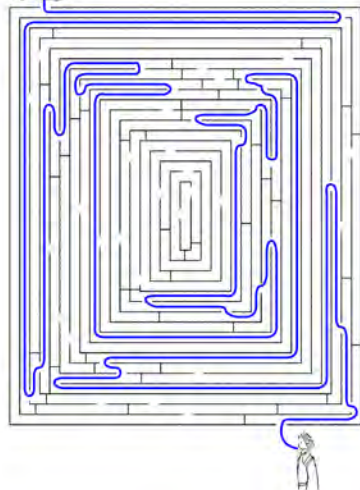
